The ideal candidate would have post-secondary education in the field of biology or sciences, a reasonable amount of directly related experience in the environmental field. The successful applicant would be expected to support the existing field and office programs including environmental monitoring, fisheries assessments, water quality monitoring, habitat assessments and more.

The position involves:

- Conducting Environmental Monitoring for construction projects including fish and amphibian salvage.
- Planning and conducting various other field programs including but not limited to water quality collection, fisheries, amphibian, bird and invertebrate assessments, habitat assessments.
- Supervision of field technicians.
- Review and preparation of technical reports.

Qualifications:

- Graduation from a recognized university with a bachelor's degree in an applicable biological, environmental sciences, or resource management science with a minimum of 4 years fisheries or environmental experience and/or 2 years of construction environmental monitoring experience.
