

## Frequently used VI commands

“CTRL b” Same as Page Up

“CTRL f” Same as Page Down

“SHIFT g” To go to the end of the document (“SHIFT g” = “G”

1 + SHIFT g To go to the beginning of the document

i Insert new text in the position of the cursor  
To exit *insert* mode type ESC (escape)

“SHIFT j” To join two consecutive lines

r Replace one character under the cursor with a new one

x Delete the character at the cursor (5x - erases 5 characters to the right)

dd Delete the line where the cursor is (5dd - deletes 5 lines down from where the cursor is)

d + 1 + “SHIFT g” Delete all the lines from the beginning of the document to the position of the cursor

d + “SHIFT g” Delete all the lines from the position of the cursor to the end of the document

u Undo the last action performed

. Repeat last change

/**<character string>** Searches for the specified **<character string>** down from the position of the cursor

?**<character string>** Searches for the specified **<character string>** down from the position of the cursor

n Repeat the previous search

:w            Save (write to disk)  
:q            Exit  
:wq          Save and exit  
:q!          Exit ignoring the changes made

To delete ^M (CTRL M) from an entire file that have not been transferred properly between Windows and Linux:

```
:%s/<CTRL V><CTRL M>//g
```

To substitute all the appearances of the character string “Converged” with “Nela” in the entire document:

```
:%s/Converged/Nela/g
```
